



Prince Alwaleed, Senegalese Minister of Tourism discusses investments

Furthermore, the Minister referred to investment opportunities in the Senegal in the hotel sector, and presented Prince Alwaleed with the proposals. In response, the Prince promised to study the investment opportunities in the Senegal.

Recently, Prince Alwaleed visited the Senegal and met with HE Mr. Macky Sall, President of the Republic of Senegal at the presidential palace. The two discussed investment, economic and general issues related to their respective countries, the meeting was also attended by Senegalese Ministers, KHC and Prince Alwaleed's private office delegation. Moreover the President honored Prince Alwaleed the presidential medal "Grand Officer De l'ordre National Du Lion."

Prince Alwaleed had visited Senegal in 2003, and met with Former President Wade. During the visit, Prince Alwaleed was awarded the highest national award, the rank of "Grand Officer of The National Order of The Lion", in recognition of his highness' visit to Senegal. His Highness had donated a total of \$1,300,000 to Senegal for the development of health and education projects there.
